ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I  
Name

The name of the corporation shall be:

Former and Concerned Citizens of Tunica, Miami Chapter, Inc.

ARTICLE II  
Principal place of business and mailing address

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation shall be:

17135 SW 107th Court, Miami, Florida 33157

ARTICLE III  
Purposes

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are

- (a) To create an awareness among present citizens of Tunica County about the local, state and federal programs that are available for their benefit and to disseminate information about these programs that will address employment, health, scholarship, educational, social and welfare needs of the community.
- (b) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, hold, own, sell, mortgage, lease or dispose of real and personal property of all kinds.
- (c) To borrow money for its corporate purposes and to make, endorse, accept execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds debentures, or other obligations from time to time for the purchase of property or for any purpose in or about the business of the corporation, and if deemed proper, to secure the payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or otherwise.
- (d) To enter into, make, perform, and carry out contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose, without limit as to the amount with any person, firm, corporation or association, with or without the security to indemnify this corporation.
- (e) To do all or any of the above things as principals, agents, contractors, trustees, or otherwise, and either alone or in conjunction with others.

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- (f) The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (g) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit or, be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.
- (h) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be for the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene including the publishing or distributing statements in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- (i) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.)
- (j) Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine.

Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IV  
Manner of election of directors

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed will be stated in the by-laws.

ARTICLE V  
Limitation of corporate powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes without limitation.
