THEODORE R. AND VIVIAN M. JOHNSON SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION, INC.

The undersigned, as an incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts these articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE 1

Name

1.1 The name of the corporation is THEODORE R. AND VIVIAN M. JOHNSON SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE 2

Initial Principal Address

2.1 The initial principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is c/o Mr. Richard A. Krause, One Harvard Circle, West Palm Beach, Florida 33409.

ARTICLE 3

Nature and Purposes

3.1 Nature and Succession

- A. The corporation is a private foundation and is not for pecuniary profit.
- **B.** The corporation is the corporate successor to The Theodore R. and Vivian M. Johnson Scholarship Foundation, a private foundation trust [hereinafter "the Foundation Trust"] created by Theodore R. Johnson by trust agreement dated May 28, 1991, with which the assets of a trust created by Vivian M. Johnson under agreement dated May 21, 1987, as amended, have been merged pursuant to a Settlement Agreement dated December 15, 1993, and approved by order of the Circuit Court of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, in and for Palm Beach County, dated December 16, 1993. These articles of incorporation and the bylaws of the corporation are intended to and shall be deemed to reconcile and supersede all provisions of the aforementioned Settlement Agreement, the aforementioned trust agreements and amendments

thereto, and the wills and codicils of Theodore R. Johnson and Vivian M. Johnson applicable to the Foundation Trust.

- C. The corporation shall take title to and possession of all assets transferred by and later acquired by or otherwise vested in the Foundation Trust and shall assume and be bound by all valid contracts entered into by the Foundation Trust.
 - D. The corporation will have perpetual duration.
- **3.2** *Purposes*. The purposes for which this corporation is formed are to provide funds for scholarships for certain categories of deserving and financially needy persons to enable them to attend institutions of higher learning that they otherwise might not be financially able to attend and to fulfill such other educational and charitable goals and objectives as the board of directors may deem appropriate.

ARTICLE 4

Limitations on Corporate Powers

- 4.1 Use of Funds. This corporation is formed as a not-for-profit corporation solely for charitable and educational purposes, and the corporation will engage in no activities, other than insubstantial ones, that do not further the purposes set forth in Article 3 hereof. No part of the corporation's net earnings will inure to the benefit of any director, officer, employee, or agent of the corporation. The corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- **4.2** Self-Dealing Prohibited. The corporation will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- **4.3** Excess Business Interests Prohibited. The corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 4.4 Jeopardy Investments Prohibited. The corporation will not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

4.5 Lobbying Expenditures Prohibited. The corporation will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE 5

Directors

5.1 *Initial Directors*. The affairs of the corporation will be managed by a board of directors pursuant to powers, duties, and responsibilities set forth in the corporation's bylaws. The board initially will comprise the following seven directors:

ARTICLE 6

Membership

6.1 The corporation will have no membership.

ARTICLE 7

Initial Registered Agent

7.1 The initial registered agent of the corporation is Richard A. Krause, whose address is One Harvard Circle, West Palm Beach, Florida 33409.

ARTICLE 8

Incorporator

8.1 The subscriber to these articles of incorporation is Theodore R. Johnson, Jr., whose address is Post Office Box 670, Freeland, Washington 98249-0670.

ARTICLE 9

Dissolution

9.1 Upon dissolution of the corporation and after payment of its just debts and liabilities, all remaining assets of the corporation will be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE 10

Amendment and Restatement

10.1 These articles of incorporation may be amended or restated by a two-thirds vote of the total number of directors in office at the time of a meeting for which proper notice, including notification of the proposed amendment, has been given.
