ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

Capital Coalition on Aging of North Florida, Incorporated

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I Name

The name of this corporation shall be Capital Coalition on Aging of North Florida, Incorporated. (A corporation not for profit).

ARTICLE II

Principle place of business and mailing address

The principle place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 1400 North Monroe Street Tallahassee, FL 32303

ARTICLE III

Purpose

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, more specifically:

- 1) To develop and provide educational materials and trainings for professional caregivers and other direct service professionals in the field of aging
- 2) To promote communication and coordination among providers of services to elders.
- 3) To conduct fund raising events to generate funds to support the cost of educational and information programs and administration of such services.
- 4) To serve as a source of information to the community on resources for elders, their caregivers and families.
- 5) To develop leadership skills in direct service, administrative, and program planning workers in the field of aging.
- 6) To solicit, accept, hold and administer any public or private grants, contracts, devises, or bequests of money, securities, or property awarded for services to older persons or purposes related thereto.

SECRETARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA •7) To conduct other programs, activities and services for or on behalf of elders and providers of serviced to elders in North Florida.

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At all times shall the following operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

- The corporation shall be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes.
- 2) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall benefit, or be distributed to its directors, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 111 hereof.
- 3) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing of distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- 4) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax or by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV Manner of election of directors

The corporation shall have one or more classes of members, as provided in the corporation's bylaws. No one will be denied membership on the basis of race, age, color, national origin, sex, disability, family status, marital status or religion. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the corporation's bylaws. The manner in which directors are elected or appointed is specified in the by-laws. Members of the first Board of Directors shall serve until the first annual meeting, at which their successors are duly elected or appointed, as provided in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V Limitation of corporate powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE VI Initial registered agent and street address

ARTICLE VII Dissolution of Corporation

At the time of dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all debts, obligations, liabilities, costs and expenses of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation. Assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state of local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principle officer of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposed or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes in no case shall a disposition be made which would not qualify as a charitable contribution under Section 170(c)(1) or (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.
