ARTICLES of INCORPORATION

For

The undersigned incorporator(s), for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article No. I-Name of the Corporation

Article No. III-Purpose of the Corporation

- (4) Artistic & Musical Development Program for Youth; and

Article No. IV-Manner of Election of Director(s)

Article No. V-Prohibition

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purpose within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principle office of the Corporation, is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

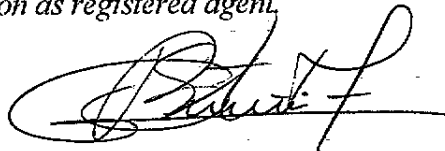
