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AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CENTER FOR POLICY IN HIGHER EDUCATION, INC.

THIS AMENDMENT to the corporate Articles of Incorporation of CENTER FOR POLICY IN HIGHER EDUCATION, INC. is made pursuant to Florida Statute 607.177(2)(a).

That the charter number of CENTER FOR POLICY IN HIGHER EDUCATION, INC. is N98000000629.

That it is the desire of the Corporation to amend the Articles of Incorporation as hereinafter specified.

1. Article II - Purposes and Powers is amended as follows:

The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is to provide information on public policy issues to higher education officials; analyze policy issues; professional development for higher education for officials; advocacy; and this corporation shall have all of the powers authorized under applicable law. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

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3. The effective date of this Amendment shall be 6-1-98 and was adopted by
the Board of Directors of the Corporation on <u>6-/-98</u> . There are no members entitled to vote. 4. That all of the provisions of the original Articles of Incorporation are hereby restated and
in full force and effect.
