## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

a Florida Corporation - Not for Profit

#### ARTICLE I

#### CORPORATE NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be:

#### ARTICLE II

ADDRESS OF PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS OF CORPORATION

### ARTICLE III

### CORPORATE PURPOSE

The purpose of this corporation shall be as follows:

- A. To preserve and protect the traditions, symbols and reputation of **Pompano Beach High School**, the **Beanpickers**, the **Golden Tornados**, and the **Blue and Gold**;
- B. To preserve and protect the artifacts, trophies, awards and other memorabilia associated with Pompano Beach High School;
- C. To foster and encourage interaction among its members, including reunions, and to maintain membership records to facilitate same;

- D. To promote the general welfare of its members and the community;
- E. To promote the development of positive relationships among its members and the community;
- F. To organize and promote participation by its members in such athletic, social, cultural, or charitable activities as may serve the corporation's purposes;
- G. To engage in or transact any and all activity or business as permitted under the laws of the United Sates and of the State of Florida; in pursuance of the foregoing purposes; subject to the following:

#### ARTICLE IV

#### PROHIBITION AGAINST PRIVATE BENEFIT

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in the furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

### ARTICLE IV

#### ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The method of election of directors shall be as provided for in the by-laws of the corporations, as may be amended from time to time.

#### ARTICLE V

#### DURATION

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual, subject to dissolution as provided in the by-laws, and as otherwise provided for by law.

#### ARTICLE VI

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

Any person who attended or graduated from Pompano High School, Pompano Senior

High school, or Pompano Beach High School, is committed to upholding the spirit and intent of all of the purposes and principals set forth in these articles, and who is in good standing as provided for by the by-laws, shall be a voting member of the association. The Board may establish other classes of membership, such as Honorary or Faculty membership, however, no such member shall have voting rights unless such member is otherwise qualified as a voting member.

#### ARTICLE VII

#### ARTICLE VIII

#### INCORPORATORS AND INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The name and address of each incorporator executing these articles of incorporation are set forth following their respective signatures below.

The three incorporators named below shall each appoint three additional directors, who shall have indicated a willingness to serve as such. The three incorporators, together with the nine additional directors thus appointed, shall constitute the initial board of directors and shall establish the requirements for voting membership and for the election and qualification of the officers and directors of the corporation. The initial board of directors shall serve until the first regular election of directors. Directors must be voting members of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE IX

#### **BY-LAWS**

The power to adopt, alter, amend, or repeal by-laws shall be vested in the Board of Directors.

### ARTICLE X

#### DISPOSITION UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purpose of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of Broward County, Florida exclusively for such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

### ARTICLE XI

### **AMENDMENTS**

The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment thereto and any right conferred upon any member is subject to this reservation.
