ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

1. There being no members of the corporation entitled to vote, the Board of Directors, on the 30th day of September, 1998, has adopted and has amended the following provisions of the Articles of Incorporation of SUFFER THE CHILDREN FOUNDATION, INC., a Florida corporation, filed in Tallahassee on February 26, 1998, be and they hereby are amended in the following particulars:

Article IV, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE IV OBJECTS, PURPOSES AND POWERS

- Section 1. This Corporation is a corporation not for profit organized for non-profit purposes and activities and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or member of the Corporation.
- Section 2. The objects and purposes for which this Corporation is organized are as follows:
- a. To publicize and act as a clearinghouse of information concerning brain and neural system cancer in children.
 - b. To conduct environmental testing to determine causes of childhood cancers.
- c. To raise funds to conduct testing, and to provide support to ill children and their families.
- d. To distribute and market environmentally safe products in order to provide funds for support of ill children, families, and to conduct environmental testing.
- e. Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- f No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried

- on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by the organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- g. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
