**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We the undersigned, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form exclusively for charitable and nonprofit purposes, under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I-NAME

The name of the corporation shall be PINEY GROVE HUMAN SERVICES CORPORATION, INC. (herein referred to as "corporation").

ARTICLE II-ADDRESS

The address of its principal office is 1100 NW 4th Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33311, or at such other place as the Board of Directors shall from time to time determine. The name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at that address is Arnold Tolbert.

ARTICLE III-PURPOSE

This is a community based nonprofit corporation created to promote family stability through in-house services, and/or coordination of outside services, in the areas of: housing, nutrition, education, drug rehabilitation, economic, social and other services, as determined necessary.

The above purposed for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue law.

ARTICLE IV-MEMBERSHIP

The qualifications of members and the manner of their admission shall be as provided in the corporation's By-Laws.

ARTICLE V-EXISTENCE

The corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE IX-AMENDMENTS AND BY-LAWS

These Articles of Incorporation and the By-Laws of the corporation may be made, altered, amend or rescinded by a majority vote of the Board of Directors, at any regular or special business meeting, provided that a notice stating the proposed change and the time and place of the meeting, where the same will be considered, has been mailed to all members of the Board of Directors at least two (2) weeks prior to such meeting.

ARTICLE X-NON-PROFIT

This corporation shall not carry on propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation or participate in political campaigns as a substantial part of its activities. No part of the income of the corporation shall be paid or inure to the benefit of any person, but the corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and may confer benefits upon its members in conformity with its purposes.

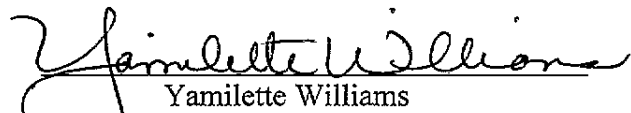
Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE XI-DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

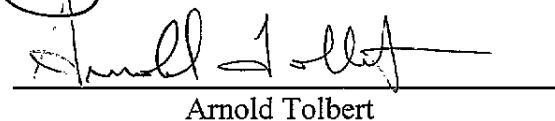
The corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit nor shall it have any power to issue certificates of stock or declare dividends and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any Director or individual. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal, state, or local government for a public purpose.

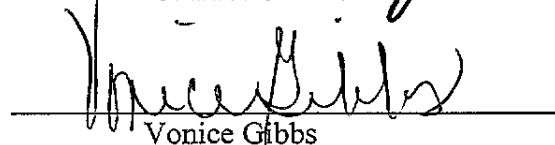

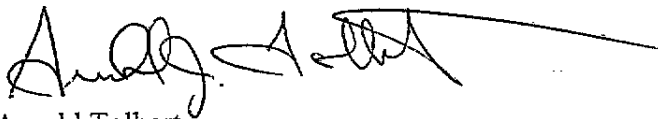
