ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION 98 MAR -2 PM 12: 55 Abundant Life Fellowship of the Palm Beaches, Inc.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following Article of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: Abundant Life Fellowship of the Palm Beaches, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

<u>ARTICLE IX - NON-PROFIT</u>




ARTICLE X - DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS
