ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FIRST TOUCH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION, INC. A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

Article 1. Name. The name of the Corporation is: FIRST TOUCH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION, INC.

Article 2. Duration. The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

Article 3. Purpose. The purpose of the corporation is as follows:

- SCALAR STATE OF THE SECOND SEC A. This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes of this corporation are to
- 1. Promote community welfare through educational and recreational programs for residents of the community.
- 2. Find and/or provide financial assistance for community residents seeking assistance for continuing education.
- B. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- C. Provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers; but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation to these people for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes.
- Article 4. Members. The Corporation shall have Voting Members, who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the Voting Members, and who shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation. The Bylaws may provide for Nonvoting Members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have such rights and privileges as are set forth in the Bylaws, but who shall not have the right to vote.
