ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

NORTH COUNTY EDUCATION FOUNDATION, INC.

The undersigned subscribers, for purposes of forming a Corporation not for profit under Chapter 617 of the laws of the State of Florida, hereby subscribe to, acknowledge and file the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

Name and address

The name of the Corporation shall be:

NORTH COUNTY EDUCATION FOUNDATION, INC.

The address of the Corporation shall be 10422 33rd Court North, Jupiter, Florida 33478.

ARTICLE II

Duration

This Corporation shall commence existence on the date of the execution and acknowledgment of these Articles if permitted by law; if not, then on the date of filing. This Corporation shall exist perpetually thereafter, unless sooner dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III

Purposes

The purpose and general nature of this Corporation is as follows:

- To increase the overall population of minority families residing within the north county area through the use of promotional opportunities or other types of marketing strategies that will reinforce the intent of the mission statement to create a racially balanced community.
- To increase the minority population within the north county schools in an effort to assist the Palm Beach County School District in achieving a racially balanced school system.

- To become involved in a wide range of educational issues that affects the student population of the north county area in an effort to increase the educational standards of achievement, and, where necessary, to coordinate with other local community groups in order to help achieve the above stated mission goal.
- To create task forces as necessary for the completion of specific tasks or projects that the North County Education Foundation feel are necessary in order to accomplish the above stated mission goal.
- To develop and forward recommendations on educational issues which may arise, including but not limited to, overall school populations, the physical condition of schools, and the auxiliary uses of school buildings.
- To work toward the goal of ensuring that children residing within the north county area are able, and are allowed, to attend neighborhood schools within the north county area.
- To enhance the development of communications between the North County Education
 Foundation and the Palm Beach County School District by seeking appointments onto
 task forces created by the School District which affect educational curriculum, school
 boundary lines, and the establishment and/or continuation of magnet programs within
 the boundaries stated herein (but not to exclude additional task forces as deemed
 necessary); or through meetings with Palm Beach County School District personnel.
- To become more fully involved with the planning and siting of any new schools that
 are intended for placement within the north county area by establishing new, and
 enhancing existing linkages with the Palm Beach County School District.
- To enhance the sustainability of the efforts of the North County Education Foundation, Inc. by attempting to obtain grants and other monies from federal, state and local governments in order to help fund the efforts of the North County Education Foundation, Inc.

The Corporation shall be organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes in accordance with the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue rule or regulation), and shall be subject to the following requirements:

A. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

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- B. No part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue rule or regulation); or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code as it now exists or as it may hereafter be amended.

The Corporation is organized pursuant to the Florida Non-Profit Corporation Act, F.S. Chapter 617 (1991), for non-profit purposes and does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.

ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE Y

Membership

The membership of the Corporation shall be open and in accordance with the By-laws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE YI

Management of Corporate Affairs

A. <u>Board of Directors</u>. The powers of this Corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors. The Corporation shall have at least three (3) and not more than nineteen (19) directors. The directors shall not be

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required to be residents of the Town of Jupiter or the Village of Tequesta; provided, however, that at all times at least three-fourths (3/4) of the members of the Board of Directors must be residents of the Town of Jupiter or the Village of Tequesta.

The names and addresses of the persons constituting the first Board of Directors who are to act in that capacity until the selection and qualification of their successors are as reflected in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The Directors shall be elected in accordance with the By-laws of the Corporation.

B. <u>Elective Officers</u>. The officers of this Corporation shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Other offices and officers may be established or appointed by the Board of Directors of this Corporation. The qualifications, the time and manner of electing or appointing, the duties of, the terms of office, and the manner of removing officers shall be as set forth in the By-laws.

ARTICLE VIII

By-laws

By-laws will be hereinafter adopted by the Board of Directors. Such By-laws may be amended, altered, rescinded or repealed, in whole or in part, by the Board of Directors in the manner provided therein. Any amendments to the By-laws shall be binding on all members of this Corporation.

ARTICLE IX

Amendment of Articles

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors and presented to a quorum of the directors for their vote. Amendments may be adopted by a vote of two-thirds (2/3)) of a quorum of directors of the corporation; provided a minimum of three-fourths (3/4) of those constituting the quorum are from the Town of Jupiter and the Village of Tequesta.

ARTICLE X

Indemnification and Limitation of Liability

The Corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director of the Corporation to the full extent permitted by law. The private property of the member shall not, unless otherwise provided by law, be subject to the payment of the corporate debts to any extent whatsoever.

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ARTICLE XI

Dissolution

In the event the Corporation is dissolved within the State of Florida and ceases to exist for the stated purposes, such certificate of dissolution shall be filed with the Secretary of State according to the Florida Statutes for dissolving a non-profit corporation. Upon such dissolution the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operating exclusively for charitable, education, religious or scientific purposes, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Rule or Regulation) and which is organized for purposes substantially similar to that of the Corporation.
