Articles of Incorporation

I. Name

The name of the corporation shall be Pillar of Truth Baptist Church, Inc. (The argual name used shall be the French equivalent, being Église Baptiste Colonne de Vérité ...

II. Principal Office

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be: 6950 Royal Palm Blvd., Amargate, FL 33063. The mailing address of this corporation shall be: 1551 NW 64 Amargate, FL 33063.

III. Purpose

The purpose of this church shall be to bring people to Jesus and to membership in His family, to develop them to Christlike maturity, and to equip them for their ministry in the church and for their life mission in the world, in order to magnify God.

This purpose shall be carried out through whatever means are possible which are in agreement with the purposes and beliefs of this church, and which do not contradict the clear teachings of the Word of God. Such means may include, but not be limited to, regularly scheduled meetings, programs of education which may include the formation of a private Christian school, and other organized service and outreach campaigns.

Further, this corporation is formed with and for all lawful purposes with the intent of qualifying for tax-exempt status in accordance with Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) as amended from time to time.

IV. Manner of Election of Directors

The directors are not elected as such, but serve ex-officio by virtue of their office in the case of the pastor, with the remaining directors' positions being filled by selection by the pastor from among individuals qualified to so serve (i.e., Associate Pastor, Assistant Pastor, Deacons, Church Legal Counsel).

The pastor of this church shall be elected by a three-fourths majority written ballot of those church members present and voting at a business meeting announced and called for said purpose.

The initial directors are: Rev. Mark A. Jacobsen, Pastor, 1551 NW 64 Ave., Margate, FL 33063; Rev. Jean-Guy Plante, Associate Pastor, 3920 NW 11 St., Coconut Creek, FL 33066; Gordon E. Schnap, Church Legal Counsel, 8950 NW 23 St., Coral Springs, FL 33065.

V. Initial Registered Agent and Street Address

The name and Florida street address of the initial registered agent are: Rev. Mark A. Jacobsen, 1551 NW 64 Ave., Margate, FL 33063.

VI. Incorporator

The name and address of the Incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation are: Mark A. Jacobsen, 1551 NW 64 Ave., Margate, FL 33063.

The church shall indemnify any person:

- Who was or is a party, or is threatened to be made a party, to any threatened, pending, or completed action, suit, or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative, or investigative (other than an action by, or in the right of, the church) by reason of the fact that the person is or was a church official, officer, employee, or agent of the church against such costs and expenses, and to the extent and in the manner provided under Florida law.
- Who was or is a party, or is threatened to be made a party, to any threatened, pending, or completed action or suit by or in the right of the church to procure judgment in its favor by reason of the fact that the person is or was a church official, officer, employee, or agent of the church against such costs and expenses, and to the extent and in the manner provided under Florida law.

The extent, amount, and eligibility for the indemnification provided herein will be made by the Board of Trustees. Said determinations will be made by a majority vote of a quorum consisting of trustees who were not parties to such action, suit, or proceeding or by the members by a majority vote of a quorum consisting of attending members who were not parties to such action, suit, or proceeding.

The church will have the power to make further indemnification as provided under Florida law except to indemnify any person against gross negligence or willful misconduct.

The church is further authorized to purchase and maintain insurance for indemnification of any person as provided herein and to the extent provided under Florida law.
