**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under Chapter 617 of the laws of the State of Florida, do hereby make and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

NAME

The name of the corporation is: **1970 BLACK ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF CORAL
GABLES SENIOR HIGH, INC.**

Article II

NOT FOR PROFIT

The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation under the of the State of Florida. The Corporation is not formed for pecuniary profit. No part of the income or assets of the Corporation is distributable to or for the benefits of it's Members, Directors or Officers, except to the extent permissible under law.

Article III

DURATION

The period of the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

Article IV

PURPOSES

The Corporation is organized exclusively for one or more the purposes as specified in section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any United States Internal Revenue Law). In operating as a Section 501 (c)(3) organization exclusively, the Corporation will carry on the following objectives and purposes :

A: To engage in civic, social and educational endeavors in the Coconut Grove area of the City of Miami and Miami-Dade County, Florida, and to promote and assist the growth and development of civic, social and educational concerns, in the Coconut Grove area, for the betterment of the community and alumni of the Coconut Grove area..

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B: To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations, including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to acquire by bequest, devise, gift, purchase, lease or otherwise any property of any sort or nature without limitation as to its amount or value, and to hold, invest, reinvest, manage, use, apply, employ, sell, expend, disburse, lease, mortgage, convey, option, donate or otherwise dispose of such property, for any of the purposes set forth herein.
