ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

WE, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida, applicable to corporations not for profit, under the following proposed Charter:

ARTICLE I.  
Name

The name of this corporation shall be THE CONCERNED CITIZENS OF DELAND, INC. and to be located in Deland, Fl. 632 W. Ioa St., Deland, Fl. 32720

ARTICLE II.  
Object

The objects and purposes of this corporation is to institutionalize in order to save our Black Youth from their apparent destiny through training and instillation of: Economic, Political and Social Ambitions; to establish and maintain liaison with all interested Black Youth gangs, groups, social clubs, churches, court and parole officers and local, city, state and national leaders; to instill a firm desire in Black youth to become useful responsible constructive citizens in their community; to instill a lofty desire in Black youth to take part in enjoying some of the better things in life which now seems to be out of reach; to re-affirm faith in human dignity, worth, and purpose of life; to promote programs to eradicate any possibilities of senseless hunger, violence or disrespect to community people on the part of merchants; to establish liaison with all interested industries using persuasive methods to induce them to place qualified Black people in so-called sensitive positions, such as: Salesmen, Personnel Managers, Public Relations and Company Representatives; also, to send some of these Black executive to talk to our youth presenting themselves as living proof.

ARTICLE III.  
Membership

That the membership of this corporation shall be composed of American Citizens, who belives in the objectives and purposes of the corporation and ascribe thereto; and who have been approved and recommended by the Recommendation Committee as an applicant for membership in this corporation.

ARTICLE IV.  
Term

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

corporation, shall be FIFTY THOUSAND (\$50,000.00) DOLLARS.

ARTICLE X.

Value of Real Estate

The amount in value of the real estate which the  
corporation may hold, subject always to the approval of the  
Secretary of State, shall be TWO HUNDRED and FIFTY THOUSAND  
(\$250,000.00) DOLLARS.
