ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

MAR 25 PM 2:43 The undersigned incorporators, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, de form a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: TRIAD/Seniors and Lawmen Together (SALT) Council of Manatee County, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be in Bradenton, Manatee County, Florida. The mailing address of this corporation shall be 5111 26th Street W., Bradenton, Florida, 34207.

ARTICLE III *PURPOSES*

- Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, literary and A. educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- The corporations will establish an effective partnership between seniors, agencies serving B. seniors in Manatee County and law enforcement. The corporation shall: heighten the awareness among law enforcement practitioners and the general community of elder persons need for dignity and security, and work toward the reduction of crime and victimization of elder persons through cooperative strategies, planning, programming and supportive services.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF SELECTION OF MEMBERS/OFFICERS

- Members and officers of the corporation shall be elected from a slate presented by the A. Nominating Committee at the corporation's annual meeting.
- В. Persons chosen shall be representatives from various agencies including but not limited to: law enforcement; American Association of Retired Persons; Crime Watch Coalition;

religious community; community organizations; healthcare industry; government; legal community; private business and private citizenry.

ARTICLE V EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

ARTICLE VI POLITICAL ACTIVITY

The corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution, this corporation will distribute any remaining assets for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction within Manatee County, Florida, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
