Distribution & Assets COPYRIGHT ASSIGNMENT

The undersigned hereby agrees and represents as follows:

- 1. The William P. Foster Foundation, Inc., ("WPFF"), is a Florida not-for-profit corporation, and is publisher and distributor of The Man Behind the Baton ("Work") pursuant to a grant of copyright and proprietary rights from the author, Dr. William P. Foster, to include all renewals, extensions, revisions and accrued rights to reproduce the Work in all media, including print and electronic form, throughout the world in any language.
- 2. The Work is an original work-for-hire by the author, and has been published and distributed by WPFF previously.
- 3. The Board of Directors of WPFF has elected to dissolve the not-for-profit corporation and desires to comply with state and federal regulations by disposing of all proprietary rights relative to the Work.
- 4. The **Friends of FAMU Libraries**, **Inc.** (the "Publisher"), is a Florida not-for-profit corporation, in Tallahassee, Florida, which was organized with a charitable purpose.
- 5. By the signature of the corporate official below, WPFF hereby grants to the Publisher, effective as of the date of this agreement, all rights held by WPFF to the Work.
- 6. WPFF explicitly assigns and transfers the following rights:
 - a. All proprietary rights including copyright.
 - b. The right to reproduce and distribute copies of the Work by hardcopy or electronically, including but not limited to photocopy, email, FTP, and online server distribution, provided that the copies are not made or distributed for direct commercial advantage; and
 - c. The right to use all or part of the Work in any future works or activities, including, but not limited to, lectures, reviews, articles, textbooks, or reprint books, which promote the Florida A&M University Department of Music, the "Marching 100 marching band, and other authorized affiliates

of the Florida A&M University Department of Music. The author, Dr. William P. Foster, has specifically reserved rights of his original life story.

As a condition of transferring these rights, WPFF agrees to transfer all existing copies of the Work to the Publisher, and, that whenever the Publisher distributes or publishes additional copies of the Work in the future, the Publisher and the author, Dr. William P. Foster, will be given first publication credit.

7. This is the entire agreement between WPFF and the Publisher, and it may be modified only in writing. It will bind and benefit successors in interest, including assignees, and licensees of the Publisher. It will terminate if the Publisher uses the Work for commercial advantage other than as provided herein.
