ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR A CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT

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Article I. NAME

RESTORATIVE JUVENILE JUSTICE PROJECT, INC.

Article II. ADDRESSES

C/O IRWIN W. BARKAN, STATUTORY AGENT
1910 VIRGINIA AVENUE, FORT MYERS, FL 33901

Article III. PURPOSES

The purposes for which the RESTORATIVE JUVENILE JUSTICE PROJECT, INC. is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law as it or they relate to the furtherance of the Balanced and Restorative Juvenile Justice process.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, State, or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction of the County in which the principle of the organization is then located, exclusively for that purpose.

Article IV. MEMBERSHIP

There shall be one class of membership open to all persons regardless of race, color, creed, religious belief, age, or gender. Upon filling out application, and having that application accepted by Board of Directors and/or the membership at large pursuant to the by-laws determined by the Board of Directors.

Article V. BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

There shall be a minimum of three Directors and a maximum of 25 and election of Directors shall be as stated in the by-laws, with the following officers to be elected as stated in the by-laws: President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer.
