ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CROSSTREET MINISTRIES, INC.

(A Corporation Not for Profit)



The undersigned, whose names are affixed hereto as incorporators, do hereby associate together for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida pursuant to Florida Statutes, Chapter 617, and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporations:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation is: CROSSTREET MINISTRIES, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The general nature, object, purpose and powers of this corporation are;

- A. To operate a Christian church teaching the Word of God;
- B. To minister to the alcoholics, drug addicts and the afflicted.
- C. To provide discipleship training, shelter, food, and clothing to as many as possible.
- D. To achieve the end result of total life renewal due to a true personal relationship with Jesus, the Son of the Living God.
- E. To inspire other Christian groups to join with us for the purpose of rehabilitating the afflicted and the social outcasts.
- F. To organize, maintain, finance, operate and conduct a church and agencies of Christian education for the promotion of Christian religion;
- G. To own, control, lease and purchase and to take by gift, devise and bequest, or otherwise, and to convey, dispose of, mortgage, encumber, lease and in every respect to do all things and exercise all powers which a natural person might do and exercise over and about real or personal property of every nature and kind whatsoever, including real estate, leaseholds, bonds, stocks and securities wherever the same may be situated or located;
- H. To maintain offices, headquarters, buildings, or other facilities for accomplishing the objects of the corporations;
- I. To issue bonds, promissory notes, securities and agreements for or evidence of, indebtedness of every character, and to mortgage, pledge or otherwise encumber property; to contract in or about properties, monies, funds or other subject matter of every character and kind whatsoever;

ARTICLE III.

ADDRESS

The initial address of the principal office of the corporation in the State of Florida is: 711 S. Third Street, Suite 11, Jacksonville Beach, Florida 32250.

The Board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office to any other address in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV.

REGISTERED AGENT

The initial registered agent of this corporation andhis address is: Edward A. Mccarthy, 711 S. Third Street, Suite 11, Jacksonville Beach, Fl 32250.

ARTICLE V.

TERM OF EXISTENCE

The term of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS, MEMBERSHIP AND OFFICERS

Section 1. Board of Directors. The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors of not less that five (5) members nor more than thirty (30) members. The number, qualification, term of office, and manner of election shall be fixed in the by-laws to be adopted by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Membership. Membership of this corporation shall consist of the Directors and Incorporators as hereinafter set. out. Additional members to be elected by the Board of Directors must have an interest in the goals and purposes of this corporation and meet the qualifications as set forth in the By-laws to be adopted by the corporation.

Section 3. Officers. The Officers of the corporation shall be a President, one or more Vice Presidents, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and such other officers as may be provided in the by-laws. The officers shall meet the qualifications as set out in the by-laws and shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors or as provided by the by-laws.

ARTICLE IX.

AMENDMENTS

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be offered by any member of the Board of Directors and may be amended by a two-third (2/3) vote of the members of the Board of Directors present at any regular meeting or at any special meeting called for that purpose.

ARTICLE X.

BY-LAWS

By-laws of this corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded by the Board of Directors in the manner set forth in the by-laws and may be offered by any member of the Board of Directors and may be amended by a two-third (2/3) vote of the members of the Board of Directors present at any regular meeting or any special meeting called for that purpose.

ARTICLE XI

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by: (a) corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law)s or (b) by a corporation, contributions of which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE XII

DISSOLUTION OF CORPORATION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the

liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purpose of the corporation id such manner or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the County Court of the country in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations or organizations as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
