
We respectfully request a waiver of the \$175.00 reinstatement fee for this non-profit corporation, due to reasonable cause. The predecessor Treasurer and registered agent had both left the organization, and did not instruct their successor regarding the Florida corporate requirement, regarding annual registration. As a result of their neglect, the corporation was administratively dissolved on September 22, 2000.

One of the first acts of Mr. Jeffrey Richman, the new treasurer and Registered Agent was to contact me, regarding the corporations legal and tax requirements. I advised him of the corporate dissolution, upon reviewing its status via www.sunbiz.org.

Because this is a non-profit organization, and due to its small size and annual budget of less than \$10,000, we respectfully request a waiver of the \$175.00 reinstatement fee.
