Article VIII: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to it's members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation, for services rendered and to make payment and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. "Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on a) by a corporation exempt from federal Income Tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code).
