

Articles of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation for

AUTOGRAPHED BOOK GIVE-AWAY FOR INNER-CITY YOUTHS, INC

Pursuant to the provision of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation filed May 19, 1998.

FIRST:

The name of this corporation is: AUTOGRAPHED BOOK GIVE-AWAY FOR INNER-CITY YOUTHS, INC.

SECOND:

The following amendments to the articles of incorporation were adopted by the corporation:

Change of Article I: CORPORATE NAME

From: The name of this corporation is: AUTOGRAPHED BOOK GIVE-AWAY FOR INNER-CITY YOUTHS, INC

To: The name of this corporation shall is: ABG HOUSING, Inc.

Change of Article II: NATURE OF BUSINESS AND POWERS

From: The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is to engage in:

- (A) The express purpose of this not for profit Corporation is to function as an enrichment program for young persons by the acquisition and distribution of published autographed books of such subject matter that can give positive inspiration. The Corporation shall actively distribute the books free of charge, with explanation of the books' content to encourage the actual reading thereof and heeding of the author's message for self-improvement. The Corporation's Motto Shall Be: Pride is instilled, where pride is given through books to our youth!
- (B) To take, secure, accept, hold or acquire, by gift, purchase, legacy or otherwise, real and personal property, when it may deem the same proper, necessary and expedient in the work and purposes for which this body was organized and incorporated; and to hold lease, encumber, give, exchange or sell and transfer and dispose of the same, in part and in whole, when it deems such action expedient, necessary or beneficial in promoting and advancing the work and purposes for which this corporation was formed; and shall have

all the powers and duties set forth under Florida and Federal laws regarding not for profit corporations, except where variances permitted by law appear in these Articles.

To: The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is to engage in:

- (A) The express purpose of this not for profit Corporation is to function as an literacy enrichment program for persons through the acquisition and distribution of homes in which the person or family promises to increase their reading skills by signed contractual agreements once residing in the home. The corporation shall develop homebuyer education programs to assist its membership, where necessary. The corporation shall further assist the person or family to acquire the property with internal and/or external down payment and closing cost assistance, where necessary. The Corporation's Mission Shall Be: To improve literacy through improved housing conditions.
- (B) To take, secure, accept, hold or acquire, by gift, purchase, legacy or otherwise, real and personal property, when it may deem the same proper, necessary and expedient in the work and purposes for which this body was organized and incorporated; and to hold lease, encumber, give, exchange or sell and transfer and dispose of the same, in part and in whole, when it deems such action expedient, necessary or beneficial in promoting and advancing the work and purposes for which this corporation was formed; and shall have all the powers and duties set forth under Florida and Federal laws regarding not for profit corporations, except where variances permitted by law appear in these Articles.
