### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

## DRAGONS HOCKEY CLUB, INC.



FIRST:

Amendment adopted: Article III is hereby amended to change the purpose of the corporation to the following purposes:

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

In the event of dissolution of this organization, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.

SECOND: The date of the adoption of the amendment was: March 24, 2000.

THIRD: The amendment was adopted by the members and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.
