ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SOUTH FLORIDA COMMUNITY-URBAN RESOURCES PARTNERSHIP, INC.

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby associate themselves together to form a Corporation, not for profit, under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be: SOUTH FLORIDA COMMUNITY-URBAN RESOURCES PARTNERSHIP, INC. (hereinafter referred to as SFCURP or corporation)

ARTICLE II

INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The initial principal office of the SFCURP is at the NRCS-UCAP office in Davie, FL. The principal office may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors of the SFCURP 6/9/ ORANGE DRIVE, Rm6/83&, DAVIE, FL 33314

DATE OF COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

The date of commencement of the corporate existence shall be upon filing with the Secretary of State. This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

<u>ARTICLE IV</u>

PURPOSE

The secure is organized for non-profit purposes as follows:

- A. To secure and give support and assistance in developing and implementing resource conservation programs for the area served by the SFCURP
- B. To serve as a clearing house for projects and programs proposed by the SFCURP Committees and Board of Directors and to furnish information relating thereto among

- local government entities, school boards and applicable agencies or civic groups.
- C. To promote sustainable economic development in the area served by the **SFCURP** through the protection, preservation, conservation, development and proper use of natural resources.
- D. To work with and assist SFCURP members in developing and implementing their objectives and goals as they relate to natural resources.
- E. To cooperate with and assist in implementing local and regional plans of other organizations and agencies beneficial to resource conservation and development in the SFCURP area.
- F. To take actions needed to secure funds to implement the purpose of the SFCURP.
- G. To provide natural resources/environmental impact information to diverse groups and communities. To conduct outreach, to include but not limited to, schools, inner city communities, minority communities, municipal governments, cross-county organizations, civic groups, nonprofits, etc.
- H. To exercise all of the powers enumerated in Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as the same now exists or is subsequently amended or superseded, and to do and perform such acts and to have such powers as shall be desirable and necessary in furtherance of any of the powers herein above enumerated which are not in derogation of the laws of the State of Florida or the United States of America; provided however, that the corporation, in exercising any one or more powers, shall do so in furtherance of the exempt purposes for which it has been organized as described in Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States of America or any amendments or additions thereto.

ARTICLE V

ACTS AFFECTING NON-TAXABLE STATUS PROHIBITED

The SFCURP is organized as a not for profit corporation within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States of America, and its activities shall be conducted for such purposes and in such a manner that no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, officer or individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the SFCURP affecting one or more of its purposes). No substantial part of the activities of the SFCURP shall be lobbying, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the SFCURP shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. The SFCURP shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent

federal tax law. The SFCURP shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 or the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax law. The SFCURP shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax law.

ARTICLE VI

NON-STOCK CORPORATION

This Corporation is organized on a non-stock basis.

ARTICLE VII

INITIAL MEMBERSHIP

The SFCURP membership may include, but is not limited to governmental agencies, profit and non-profit organizations, schools and interested persons. The authorized number, types of memberships and qualifications of the members of the SFCURP, the manner of their admission, the voting and other rights and privileges of members shall be set forth in the Bylaws.
