ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SHAMA SCHOOL OF PRECEPTS, INC.

A NOT FOR PROFIT ORGANIZATION

THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as sole incorporator of the SHAMA SCHOOL OF PRECEPTS, INC. under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I Name of Corporation

The name of the Corporation shall be the SHAMA SCHOOL OF PRECEPTS, INC.

ARTICLE II <u>Duration of Corporation</u>

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III Stock

The Corporation is to have no capital stock.

ARTICLE IV Not-For Profit Status

The Corporation is not organized for any pecuniary profit and shall have no power to make or declare dividends, and no part of its net earnings shall benefit any of the members of the Corporation. No person, firm or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profits form the undertaking of this Corporation. Upon dissolution of this Corporation, all of its assets remaining after payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed to any charitable organization which have qualified for exemption under Section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the Federal Government, or to a State or Local Government, or for a public purpose, and none of the assets will be distributed to any member, or officer of this Corporation.

ARTICLE V Principal Office

The address of the Principal Office of the corporation is 20945 Shady Grove Road, Groveland, Florida 34736. The location of the Principal Office shall be subject to change as may be provided in By-Laws duly adopted by the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI Mailing Address

The mailing address of the corporation is P.O. Box 246, Center Hill, Florida 33514.

ARTICLE VII Initial Registered Office and Agent

The address of the initial Registered Office of the corporation is 20945 Shady Grove Road, Groveland, Florida 34736, and the initial Registered Agent at such address is Helen Johnson.

ARTICLE VIII Initial Board of Directors

The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is 3. The number of directors shall be reconsidered at the first annual meeting of the Board of Directors and thereafter may be increased or decreased from time to time, but in no event shall the number of Directors be less than three (3) or more than seven (7) after the first annual meeting of the Board of Directors. The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be determined and set out in the bylaws. The person who is to serve as the initial Director until such successor Directors are elected or shall qualify is:

- 1. Clifford Johnson
- 2. Helen Johnson
- 3. Gloria O'Hagan

ARTICLE IX Purpose of Corporation

The purpose of Shama School of Precepts, Inc. is to provide a non-profit Christian education alternative for individuals seeking to educate in an optimally parent-directed system by: encouraging biblically-based character training and life skills; keeping records in academics in accordance with the state recommendations; offering advice/support in the area of curriculum, credits, and instruction; offering annual standardized testing; and supplying high school transcripts and graduation diplomas. The Corporation, however, shall not be empowered to conduct any other activities, other than as an insubstantial part of its activities, which are not in furtherance of one or more of the above-referenced purposes. It being expressly stated that the Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, education and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No substantial part of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene, in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax code section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions which are deductible under 170(C) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any federal tax code.

ARTICLE X Membership

The basis upon which membership is determined shall be more fully set forth in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE XI Bylaws

The Board of Directors shall have full power and authority to adopt such By-Laws, Rules and Regulations as they may deem necessary for the proper operation of the Corporation in order that it performs those functions and things for which it is organized. That all such By-Laws, Rules and Regulations shall not be in violation of the laws of the State of Florida, or the Laws, Rules and Regulations of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States.
