ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION

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UNITED FAMILY ASSOCIATED, INC.

We the UNDERSIGNED, natural person of legal age acting as incorporators, do hereby associate ourselves together to become incorporated under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statures applicable to not-for-profit corporations and adopt the following Article of incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is United Family Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The purpose(s) for which this corporation is organized are: "To operate a NOT-FOR-PROFIT Charitable Organization, associated together with persons, associations and corporation promoting Educational and Cultural Development which are exclusively Scientific and Literary." And any other lawful business activity for which not-for-profit corporation may be incorporated under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statues, and within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, and or corresponding provisions of any Revisions and future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE IV - MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The Manner in which the directors are qualified, elected or appointed is as follows: Each year at its General annual meeting, the members of the corporation shall elect a board of directors to serve for the ensuing year as provided in the by-law.

ARTICLE V - REGULATION OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS

The Internal affairs of this corporation are governed by the "BY-LAWS" which shall be established and approved by the majority of the directors at the First meeting of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI - LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS

The corporate powers of the corporation are as provided in section 617.0302 Florida Statues. There are no provisions limiting the powers of the corporation except as prohibited by section 617.0833 of the Florida Statues.

ARTICLE REGISTERED OFFICE, AGENT AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE IX - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section L. This corporation shall be operated by a Board of Directors. The By-Laws may provide another name for the Board of Directors and other wise provide for the extent and limit of their powers, duties and privileges, and further, shall provide the manner of appointment, qualification or election and other matters relating thereto; Subject to restrictions herein including:

a) The number of directors may be provided in the By-Laws but at all times shall not be less than three (3).
