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DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS
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ARTICLE I.

NAME

Section 1.1 The name of this organization shall be the Alliance of Appointed Ambassadors, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

ARTICLE III.

PURPOSES

Section 3.1 **Purposes**
The organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Specifically, the organization is organized for the purpose of the advancement of Christianity and the promotion of social welfare, and to undertake such activities as will further the general purposes described therein.

ARTICLE IV.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 4.1 **Election**

Directors shall be elected in the manner set forth in the Bylaws of the corporation.

Section 4.2 **Number**

This organization shall have three (3) Directors initially. The number of Directors may be increased or reduced from time to time, as provided in the Bylaws of the corporation; however, the corporation shall at all times have at least three (3) Directors.

Section 4.4 **Executive Committee**

The Board of Directors may, pursuant to a resolution adopted by a majority of all of the members of the Board, designate two (2) or more of its members to constitute an executive committee, which, to the extent provided in such resolution, may exercise the powers of the Board of Directors, exclusions listed in By-laws.

ARTICLE V.

LIMITATIONS

Section 5.1 Limitations on Actions

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any member, director, officer, or other private person, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to confer benefits on its members in conformity with the purposes set forth in Section 3.1 of these Articles. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

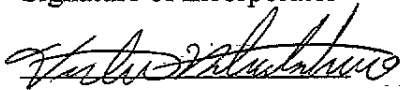
