ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COMMUNITY COUNSELING CENTER, INC

Pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes pertaining to "not for profit corporations" the following "articles of incorporation" are adopted by Community Counseling Center, Inc.

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is **Community Counseling Center, Inc.**

ARTICLE TWO

The principle office and mailing address is 4815 East Lake Drive, Winter Springs, Fl 32708.

ARTICLE THREE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida Corporation Act pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes for "not for profit" corporations.

The primary functions of said corporation shall be that of:

1) Religious: By providing Pastoral counseling for individuals, families, couples, and children.

Working with **all** religious denomination in providing individual pastoral counseling, organizing support and therapy groups, and creating workshops For the "church" leadership.

- 2) Educational: developing and providing educational seminars for both church families and families within the communities in dealing with various concerns facing these individuals and families.
- 3) Charitable: By providing (as financial resources allow) "professional pastoral" counseling to individuals, families, and couples who are unable to financially afford professional therapy.

Said corporation/organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including for such purposed, the making of distributions to organizations under section 501© (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding sections of any future Federal tax codes).

No part of the net earning of the corporation/organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501© (3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation/organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation/organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation/organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501© (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170© (2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

ARTICLE FOUR

Upon the dissolution of this corporation/organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501© (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or shall be distributed to the Federal Government or to the state or local government for a public purpose.

ARTICLE FIVE

The "directors" shall be appointed by the incorporators to serve for the duration of 2 years. Each director shall be an "ordained" minister of a recognized denomination.

ARTICLE SIX

The street address of its initial registered office is 4815 East Lake Drive, Winter Springs, FL 32708, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Charles A. Wise.

The registered office address is the same as the principle address.
