## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT to ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of



## Branch of the Lord, Inc.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

First: Amendment(s) adopted: (indicate article number (s) being amended, added or deleted.)

Article VII (added)- Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Article IV (added)- Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c0 3 of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

Article X (added)- Upon dissolution of this corporation assests shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 591 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to state or local government for a public purpose.
