ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

YOUTH MAKING A CHANGE (YMAC), Inc.

- ARTICLE I:** The name of the corporation shall be **Youth Making A Change (YMAC), Inc.** This corporation is organized pursuant to the FLORIDA Non-Profit Corporation Codes.
- ARTICLE II:** The principal place of business and mailing address of this Corporation shall be **903 S. Ridge St., Lake Worth, FL 33460.**
- ARTICLE III:** The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is as follows: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and no part of any net earnings shall ensure to the benefit of any private member. There will be several Community Services Programs organized to operate through this nonprofit Corporation. They are as follows: (1) ***Peep-Parent Education Empowerment Program***; (2) ***TORCT: Teachers on Reach Comprehensive Training Programs*** provides training to ensure the quality of child care by strengthen providers knowledge base. Pro-adolescent mentoring programs; provide support services for businesses and organizations in need of information for start up, staff development, informational networking and Basic life skills training. Provide educational training to Child Care Providers and Parents/legal Guardians to obtain their ***National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC)*** Certificate. Provide resources and training for after prison care ***Reality After Prison*** services. (RAP) Provide educational training for Employment opportunities for families overcoming welfare, Project FOW: ***Families Overcoming Welfare***, targeting inner city families who are recipients of public assistance and requiring training and development (activity) in order to acquire employment. ***Senior Enrichment Program (SEP)*** Alpha and Omega Child Development Center. ***Providing Assistance to Community Homeless*** (patch) and families affected with HIV.
- ARTICLE IV:** The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows: The Board of Directors will serve a one year term. Each director shall hold office authority to appoint other staff personnel as needed. In the event that an official position is vacated, the Board shall appoint a temporary replacement for the position until an official election can be conducted. **The names and addresses of the persons appointed to act as the initial directors or the corporation are:**

The property of this corporation irrevocable dedicated to Charitable and Educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever ensure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or the benefit Of any private person. On dissolution of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision of payment of all debts, and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for Charitable and Educational Programs under **Section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code**. The duration of this corporation shall be Perpetual, no stock and shall have no members.

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for Educational and Charitable purposes within the meaning of **Section © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code**. Notwithstanding Any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activity not permitted (1) by a corporation Exempt from federal income tax under **Section © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code**; (2) by a corporation contribution's To which are deductible under **Section 17 © (2) of the Internal Revenue Code**.

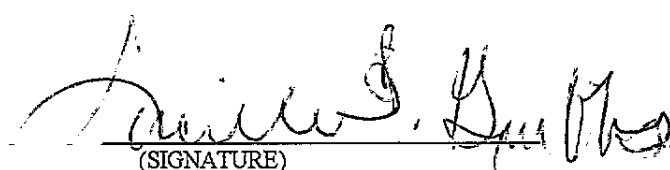
