The undersigned Incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit · Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1
NAME

This corporation shall be known as Godsoldiers Outreach Center, Evangelistic Association and Churches

# ARTICLE 2 PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The name of the county in the State of Florida in which the said registered office of the corporation is Orange County. The initial local address of the Godsoldiers Outreach Center, Evangelistic Association and Churches Worldwide, Inc. is 7476 Groveoak Drive, Orlando, Florida 32810.

# ARTICLE 3 DURATION

The duration of the Godsoldiers Outreach Center and Evangelistic Association and Churches Worldwide, Inc. shall be perpetual unless the Board of Directors votes to terminate the corporation by unanimous decision.

# ARTICLE 4 **PURPOSE**

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are the following:

- The main purpose of the corporation is religious, as the word is exemplified in the Bible. The corporation shall be organized under the Nonprofit Religious Corporation Law of Florida exclusively for 1. religious purposes, within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities, not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 2. (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- To provide a place of refuge for the homeless abused, sick, and poor. 3.
- To provide a place of worship based on the Christian faith. 4.
- To teach God's Word to those that desire to become a Christian. 5.
- To promote unity within the Body of Christ. 6.
- To produce, and provide all necessary physical facilities and resources for the corporation and Church. 7. To administer such property, facilities and resources for the Church.
- To purchase, acquire, lease, sell and dispose of property, both real and personal, and to use, encumber, 8. pledge, mortgage, lease, and otherwise deal in the same at pleasure to the same extent as a natural person can do.
- To make and execute deeds, mortgages, releases and instruments of indebtedness, negotiable or nonnegotiable, and to enter into and execute contracts of every kind and character with any person, firm, or 9. corporation.

#### **Initial BOD Members**

## Occupancy

This corporation is to maintain at least two and a maximum of seven Directors throughout the duration cited in Article 3. The goal of the corporation is to maintain a seven-seat occupancy on the Board of Directors. If this is not attainable, as soon as possible, the vacant position should be filled.

### Vacancy

Once vacancy occurs within the seven-seat Board of Directors, the current board shall appoint a member of the corporate body (defined under Membership Section in the Bylaws) as a Director with an quorum of 100% by majority vote, after thoroughly evaluating all of the nominee's qualifications and leadership abilities as stated in the Bylaws.

#### Terms

The terms of the Board of Directors are until they resign or become decease. If there are any serious problems occurring with any BOD member, defined by the Chairman of BOD, the BOD may remove that BOD member with 100 % quorum and 90 % majority vote.

## Roles and Responsibilities

The Chairman of the BOD shall be the representative of the corporation, unless delegated otherwise. BOD shall elect one of the directors as Chairman. The Chairman shall preside over all BOD meetings and elections. The Chairman shall share equal voting power with the other BOD members. The Chairman of the corporation shall have authority over all members of the corporation and church. The BOD shall decide amongst themselves whom will take minutes and provide all applicable documents for each meeting. The BOD is organized to be the decision-maker of the corporation and church.

#### Voting

The purpose of the BOD is to have equal counsel, through voting privileges. Only when necessary, shall the Chairman make a final decision, which he/she feels that is in the best interest of the corporation, of which decision, may conflict with initial decision of the BOD. All BOD members shall have one equal vote in all elections. Though the BOD and Executive Board (EB) are different Committees, BOD members may hold no more than one position on the Executive Board, if approved by the BOD with 100% quorum and majority vote. If this occurs, the BOD member, as an EB nominee, shall also file an application with the Executive Director. If a member of the BOD decides to be an Executive Board member, he/she will have only one vote though he/she may hold multiple positions. Only Board of Directors and Executive Board (BODEB) members has voting privileges in the corporation.

### Meetings

When the Executive Board, as noted in the bylaws, schedule their meetings and elections, at least one BOD member shall be present for the meeting to be official. BOD members shall have a separate meeting once a month, excluding the joint BODEB meeting to be held once a month.

BOD- one meeting per month

EB- one meeting per month

BODEB- one meeting per month
