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

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF**

SYMPOSIUM SINGERS, INC.

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The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation providing for the formation, liability, rights, privileges and immunities of a corporation not for profit:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be: Symposium Singers, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Principal place of business and mailing address: The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: 2008 Robinson Avenue, Sarasota, Florida 34232-3234.

ARTICLE III

The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is: To serve and educate the public through the use of choral music by creating and maintaining an ad hoc panel of qualified and trained singers to perform benefit concerts for charitable purposes, to sponsor musical events in the community and to present workshops in the choral and vocal arts, as well as to transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under Chapters 607 and 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall exist perpetually, and shall commence upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Department of State, State of Florida.

ARTICLE V

The registered office of the corporation shall be at: 2008 Robinson Avenue, Sarasota, Florida 34232-3234, and the registered agent at that address shall be James Cullen.

ARTICLE VI

The business of this corporation shall be conducted by the directors. The manner in which the directors are elected shall be designated by the By-laws of the corporation, and shall be so elected at the annual meeting.

ARTICLE VII

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II.

This corporation shall have all the powers conferred upon corporations not-for-profit as provided by general law, and specifically as set forth by the Florida Not-For-Profit Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE X

The By-laws of this corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors and may be altered, amended or rescinded in the manner provided by said By-laws.

ARTICLE XI

All officers and directors shall be indemnified by the corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including attorneys fees reasonably incurred in connection with any proceeding or settlement thereof in which they may become involved by reason of holding such office. The corporation may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of all officers and directors against any liability asserted against them or incurred by them in their capacity as officers and directors or arising out of their status as such.

ARTICLE XII






