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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

to

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

Seminole Home Based Emergency Assistance Response Team, Incorporated

(present name)

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendment(s) adopted: (INDICATE ARTICLE NUMBER(S) BEING AMENDED, ADDED OR DELETED.)

Amend ARTICLE III PURPOSE

To determine needs of survivors of a declared disaster through response case management
To find human and other resources in the community to meet those needs.
To maintain an organization for declared disaster relief readiness.
To share the information of preparedness and response recovery.

Add ARTICLE VII Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, Seminole H.E.A.R.T. shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Add ARTICLE VIII In the event of dissolution of Seminole H.E.A.R.T., the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.
