ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

THE JACKSONVILLE CHILDREN'S CHORUS, INC.

TAPLAHASSEE FLORIDA

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida Non-Profit Corporation, adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

#### FIRST:

Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

### **ARTICLE IV LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS**

The Corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in §617.0302 of the Florida Statutes. The corporation shall not exercise any of its powers for pecuniary profit and shall not perform any function prohibited to corporations not-for-profit by the laws of the State of Florida.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or

corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

SECOND:

Article VIII of the Articles of Incorporation is added to read as follows:

ARTICLE VIII

Upon dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more

exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue

Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of

any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a

state or local government for a public purpose.

THIRD:

The date of the adoption of the Amendments was September 7, 1999.

**FOURTH:** 

The Amendments were adopted by the members, and the number of votes cast for the

Amendments was sufficient for approval.
