### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## JCR FELLOWSHIP FOR YOUTH FOUNDATION, INC. A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation

# ARTICLE I - CORPORATE NAME AND PRINCIPAL ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is JCR FELLOWSHIP FOR YOUTH FOUNDATION, INC., and the principal address of the corporation is 120 Annwood Road, Palm Harbor, FL 34685.

#### ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

# ARTICLE III - PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE CORPORATION IS ORGANIZED

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for charitable, religious, literary, scientific, and educational purposes as set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as tax exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of such code, or any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax law.

#### ARTICLE IV - PROHIBITED TRANSACTIONS

This corporation shall not:

- A. Engage in any activities prohibited by Section 617.0835, Florida Statutes;
- B. As a substantial part of its activities, carry out propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation;
- C. Participate or intervene, by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise, in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office;
- D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

#### ARTICLE V - DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable, religious, literary, scientific, and educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof.

#### **ARTICLE VI - MEMBERSHIP**

The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the Board of Directors. Any person making application for membership as provided for in the Bylaws and agreeing to be bound by the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation, by its Bylaws, and by such rules and regulations as the Board of Directors may from time to time adopt, is eligible for membership in the corporation. The Board of Directors shall from time to time prescribe the form and manner in which application may be made for membership. The rights and privileges of the

members of the corporation are as provided in the Bylaws of the corporation. Members shall have no voice or vote in the business affairs of the corporation.

# ARTICLE VII - REGISTERED AGENT AND INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 120 Annwood Road, Palm Harbor, FL 34685. The name of the initial registered agent at such address is BRENDA DUPUIS-ROYER.

#### ARTICLE VIII - INITIAL DIRECTORS

There shall be three (3) directors constituting the initial Board of Directors. The name and address of each person who is to serve as an initial director is as follows:

#### **ARTICLE IX - INCORPORATOR**

#### ARTICLE X - MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a Board of Directors. The number of directors of the corporation shall be not less than three (3) and may be such number greater than three (3) as may, from time to time, be voted upon by the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors named in Article VIII shall hold office until the first annual meeting of the Board of Directors to be held as prescribed in the Bylaws but in no event later than twelve (12) months from the date of incorporation, at which time an election of directors shall be held. The manner in which directors are elected shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the corporation.

Directors elected at the first annual meeting and at all times thereafter shall serve for a term of not less than one (1) year and until the qualification of their successors in office. The Board of Directors may, in the Bylaws of the corporation or by separate resolution, provide for staggered terms of office of the directors.

#### **ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENTS**

The Articles of Incorporation of the corporation may be amended by the Board of Directors by resolution proposed and considered at any regular meeting of the Board of Directors but which may not be adopted until the next succeeding regular meeting of the Board of Directors and then only by unanimous vote. The Bylaws of the corporation shall be made,

altered, amended, or rescinded by a majority vote of the Board of Directors at a meeting of the Board of Directors called for such purpose.

#### **ARTICLE XII - DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS**

Upon dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, or educational purposes which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
