ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF FLORIDA CARDIOVASCULAR INSTITUTE RESEARCH FOUNDATION, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the Corporation shall be:

Florida Cardiovascular Institute Research Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address

The principal place of business and mailing address of this Corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III

Purposes

The specific purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

To engage exclusively in charitable, educational, and scientific activities in which non-profit corporations in Florida may be involved, including specifically to carry out cardiovascular research and educational programs to enhance and improve the understanding and treatment of cardiovascular diseases and to promote and advance cardiovascular health, including the conduct of continuing medical education programs for health professionals and the general public, and

to provide medical care to the sick and injured persons who may come to the Corporation for diagnosis, treatment and care, without regard to race, color, creed, sex, age, or ability to pay, and in doing so, the Corporation shall be subject to the following:

- (a) No part of the income or corpus of this Corporation shall be diverted in any manner, directly or indirectly, or otherwise inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, or officer of the Corporation or other private individual or entity; provided, however, that the Corporation is authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered by its employees.
- (b) The Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign for any political office, directly or indirectly. The Corporation shall not engage in the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except insofar as it relates to the furthering of the purposes of the Corporation, and then only as an insubstantial part of its activities.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried out (i) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- (d) On dissolution, all assets of the Corporation shall be paid over to such fund or non-profit corporation which is engaged in medical education and research as the Directors may determine, provided that such organization or organizations qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
