ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ON SEP ON THE PORT OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PROP CHRISTIAN AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR SUPPORT, INC.

We, the undersigned residents of the State of Florida, being twenty-one (21) years or more of age, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the statutes of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE ONE

NAME AND LOCATION

The name of the corporation shall be CHRISTIAN AUTOMOTIVE REPAIR SUPPORT, and its location shall be 4650 East Highway 20, City of Niceville, County of Okaloosa State of Florida 32578.

ARTICLE TWO

PURPOSE

Said corporation is organized to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes and which such organizations exist exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes as determined under Sections 501(c)(3) and 170 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE THREE

PROHIBITED ACTS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in ARTICLE TWO. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt for Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE FOUR

STOCK

The corporation shall be a nonstock corporation, and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared or paid to the members thereof.

ARTICLE FIVE

DIRECTORS

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is Five (5), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as initial directors are as follows:

GENERAL OFFICERS

ARTICLE SEVEN


