**AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

**AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE I:** The name of the corporation is amended to Captive Heart Prison Ministry, Inc.

**AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II:** The initial principal address of the corporation for reporting and filing purposes is amended to P.O. Box 1322, Sneads, FL 32460.

**AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE III:** The purpose of the corporation is amended to the following: The purpose for which this corporation is organized is for the practice of the Christian religion through the worship of Almighty God and His Son Jesus Christ; to carry out evangelistic efforts in correctional facilities throughout the world; including organizing and participating in prison crusades, religious education classes, and any other activities deemed necessary and proper in keeping with the Christian faith. The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, educational and scientific purposes, within the means of Section 501 (c) (3), of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provisions of any future Internal Revenue Law).

**AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE V** The initial registered agent and street address is amended to C.A. Peavy, % Howard Goodson, P.O. Box 1322, 8062 Eugenia Street, Sneads, FL 32460

**THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL ARTICLES HAVE BEEN ADOPTED:**

**ARTICLE VII**

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual, unless dissolved according to law. Corporate existence shall commence upon filing with the Secretary of State. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the means of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be

distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

#### ARTICLE VIII




No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501 (c) (3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

#### ARTICLE IX

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 107 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

#### ARTICLE X

However, if the named recipient is not then in existence or no longer a qualified distributee, or unwilling or unable to accept the distribution, then the assets of this corporation shall be distributed to a fund, foundation or corporation, organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).
