Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation, filed October 8, 1998, number of N98000005798.

FIRST: The name of the corporation is COMMITTEE FOR FLORIDA CONSUMERS, INC., A Non-Profit Corporation.

SECOND:

ARTICLE IV., Purposes, is hereby amended to read as follows:

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted by this corporation, together with and in addition to the authority and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida, is to engage in dialogue and educational efforts to establish programs for consumer protection. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitte dto be carried on the the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The corporation shall have all of the general authority and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida subject to these Articles of Incorporation and by-laws to be adopted to do all things necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of the above purposes and any one or more of them.

THIRD:

This amendment was adopted by the Board of Directors on the 19th day of October, 1998.
