# **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

of

# SERVING THE LORD OF GLORY CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted:

## ARTICLE III. GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES

- A. The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to advance the principles and teachings of Biblical Christianity in the lives of individuals and corporate assemblies of believers consistent with the teachings of the Holy Bible, God's infallible Word, and for such other charitable purposes by the distribution of its funds for such purposes and more particularly for the following:
  - 1. To teach and disciple individuals in Biblical truths;
  - 2. To do all and everything necessary, suitable, proper or desirable for the accomplishment or attainment of any of its purposes or the furtherance of any of the powers enumerated herein or necessary or incidental to benefit SERVING THE LORD OF GLORY CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES, INC. and protection of the corporation, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals; and to do every other act or acts, thing or things, necessary or incidental to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid purposes or any part or parts thereof.
- B. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- C. This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

# ARTICLE IX. DISTRIBUTION OF ASSESTS

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501 (c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendments was: February 20, 1999.

THIRD: Adoption of Amendment

There are no members or members entitled to vote on the amendments. The amendments were adopted by the unanimous decision of The Board of Directors.
