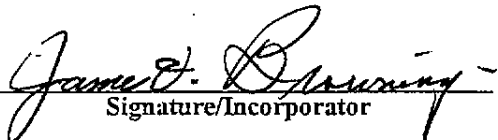

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE CIRCUIT COURT IN AND FOR
LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA

The undersigned subscribers and petitioners would
respectfully report that they are desirous of forming a cor-
poration, not for profit, under the provisions of Chapter
617, Florida Statutes 1941, and to that end have associated
together and propose a Charter for such corporation, with the
following provisions, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.

NAME AND LOCATION

The name of this corporation shall be the Earthside
Citizens League Inc., a non-profit corporation, and its lo-
cation is to be New Prospect, Lee County, Florida.

ARTICLE II.

OBJECT OF CORPORATION

The general nature of the object of this corporation
is to promote and create friendship, good will, cooperation,
and brotherhood among the citizens of New Prospect and its
surrounding communities, and to maintain a community house for
the members and their friends to gather in, and to carry on their
programs, and to use and maintain the necessary furnishings
for such community house.

There shall be a fee of one dollar (\$1.00) per year
levied upon each active member of said organization. Any member,
may be expelled from the organization by a two-thirds vote of the
active membership, after giving of ten days written notice to the
person involved, and affording him an opportunity to be heard by
the active membership at a meeting assembled for that purpose.

ARTICLE IV.

This organization shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V.

All said subscribers are residents of New Prospect,
Lee County, Florida.

to this corporation shall be managed by
President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer
and a member. They shall hold office for a term of one
year from the date of their election or until their successors
are elected and qualified.

4. In addition there shall be such other officers and
committees with such duties and authorities as the president
shall appoint and designate, subject to the confirmation by
the active membership.

ARTICLE VIII

ELECTIONS

On or before six months from the date of the granting
of this charter by the Circuit Judge, a time and place for the
holding of the first regular election shall be fixed by vote of
the active membership for the election of the first regular
officers of this corporation. For the purpose of conducting
this election and all elections, an election committee shall be
appointed. At least ten days written notice of this and all
elections shall be given by this Election Committee and it shall
be their duty to supply to the members all necessary forms and
ballots for voting. Each active member shall be entitled to
nominate one qualified candidate for each office and such nomi-
nations may be filed in writing with the Election Committee
on before the meeting held for such election, and nominations
may be made from the floor of the election meeting. Ballot in-
at the election meeting shall be secret. All other procedures,
rules and regulations for the conducting and holding of elections
shall be as prescribed by the by-laws.

ARTICLE IX.

BY-LAWS

The by-laws of this corporation shall be made, ~~revised~~ ^{Amended}, amended or rescinded by a majority vote of the active membership at any regular, adjourned, or special meeting called for that purpose at which there is a quorum present, and after one week written notice accordingly. This Charter can be amended only by a two-thirds vote of the active membership, at a meeting called as hereinabove provided as to by-laws, and thereafter upon proper application to the Circuit Court.

ARTICLE X.

INDEBTEDNESS

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability that this corporation may at any time subject itself shall be five thousand Dollars (\$5000.00), which, however, such indebtedness shall never exceed two-thirds of the value of the property of the corporation.

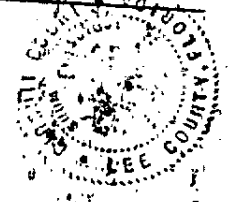
