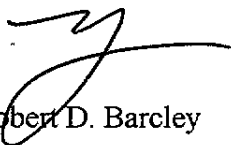

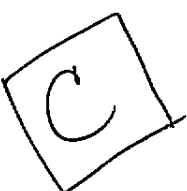

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
FOR  
Igreja Pentecostal Bethel, Inc.**

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of **Igreja Pentecostal Bethel, Inc.**, under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, submits the following Articles of Incorporation.

**ARTICLE I. NAME**

The name of the corporation shall be: **Igreja Pentecostal Bethel, Inc.**

**ARTICLE II. DURATION AND COMMENCEMENT**

The corporation will exist perpetually, commencing upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Florida Department of State.

**ARTICLE III. PURPOSE**

The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or as otherwise exempt from such provisions as a religious institution, including, but not limited to the following:

To function as a church associated with the Assemblies of God, and all purposes associated with the call and function of a church.

The purposes of the corporation shall also include the performance of activities related or incidental to the furtherance of the corporation's stated purpose and permitted under the laws of the United States and Florida.

**ARTICLE IV. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES**

The corporation shall not engage in any activities prohibited by Chapters 617.9835 of the Florida Statutes, but shall otherwise have all powers provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

## **ARTICLE V. MEMBERS**

The qualifications for members of the Corporation and the manner of their admission shall be as regulated by the Bylaws.

## **ARTICLE VI. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT**

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 554 60th Street South, St. Petersburg, Florida 33707, and the corporation's initial registered agent at that address is Jose daSilva.

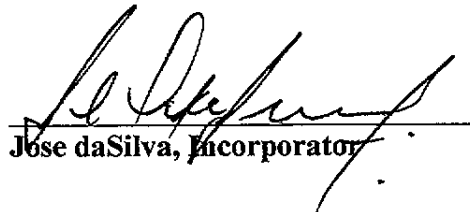

No part of the assets or net earnings of the corporation may be distributed or inure to the benefit of any individual, or otherwise as provided for in Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes.

#### ARTICLE XI. AMENDMENTS

The corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provision in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner prescribed by law.

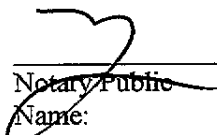
