

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

THE RINKER COMPANIES FOUNDATION, INC.

These Articles of Incorporation are signed and acknowledged by the incorporators for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes Annotated, as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation is:
THE RINKER COMPANIES FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The purpose or purposes of this corporation are as follows:

charitable, scientific, testing for public safety, literary or educational purposes, or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals, all for public welfare and for no other purposes, and to that end to take and hold, by bequest, devise, gift, purchase or lease, either absolutely or in trust, for such objects and purposes or any of them, any property, real, personal or mixed, without limitation as to the amount or value, except such limitations, if any, as may be imposed by law; to sell, convey and dispose of any such property and to invest or re-invest the principal thereof and to deal with and expend the income therefrom for any of the abovementioned purposes without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received; to

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receive any property, real, personal or mixed, in trust under the terms of any will, deed of trust or other trust instrument for the foregoing purposes or any of them (but for no other purposes) and in administering the same, to carry out the directions and exercise the powers contained in the trust instrument under which the property is received, including the expenditure of the principal as well as the income, for one or more of such purposes as authorized or directed in the trust instrument under which it is received; to receive, take title to, hold and use the proceeds and income of stocks, bonds, obligations or other securities of any corporation or corporations, domestic or foreign, but only for the foregoing purposes or some of them; and in general to exercise any, all and every power for which a non-profit corporation organized under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes Annotated for the foregoing purposes, all for the public welfare, can be authorized to exercise, but not any other power. No part of the net earnings herefrom shall inure to the benefit of any private member or trustee or to any contributor hereto. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

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The number of members of this corporation shall be not less than seven (7) nor more than fifteen (15) as may be fixed from time to time by the members. The members of this corporation shall also be the trustees thereof so that the number of members shall also be the number of trustees. Rembers may be elected at any annual or special meeting of members held for

that purpose by vote of a majority of the remaining members, although less than a quorum, or by a sole remaining member, and the admission of a person as a member shall constitute his election also as a trustee. When a person ceases to be a member or ceases to be a trustee he shall no longer either be a member or a trustee. The members, each of whom shall be a trustee, shall be elected for a term of three (3) years or until the expiration of their respective terms, if elected to fill a vacancy, and until their respective successors are elected. No membership, trusteeship or interest in this corporation shall be assignable inter vivos, nor shall any membership, trusteeship or interest in this corporation pass to any personal representative, heir or devisee.
