ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
TRANSITIONAL GARDENS, INC.

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SECRETARY OF STATE  
TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I  
NAME

The name of the corporation shall be TRANSITIONAL GARDENS, INC., a Florida not-for-profit corporation.

ARTICLE II  
PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

306 Chapel Hill Boulevard  
Boynton Beach, Florida 33435

ARTICLE III  
PURPOSE

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized are:

- A. To provide transitional housing for women that:
  - (i) have been recommended from other programs;
  - (ii) need a retreat environment;
  - (iii) need help to get to correct facility;
  - (iv) need Christian fellowship to enable them to be refreshed; or
  - (v) need temporary housing.
- B. To establish a fellowship Center for self-help groups.
- C. To establish and furnish a religious, motivational and inspirational tape and book library.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the Articles.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on or propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### ARTICLE IV DIRECTORS

The number of initial directors of this corporation shall be three (3), and the names and addresses of the initial directors are as follows:

The method of election of the directors shall be stated in the Bylaws of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE V DURATION

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual.

#### ARTICLE VI MEMBERS

The corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE VII  
DEDICATION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed to a not-for-profit Christian women's organization qualifying as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
