ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF JUG CREEK CONSERVATION CLUB, INC.

THE UNDERSIGNED incorporator, desiring to form a corporation not for profit under the provisions of <u>Florida Statutes</u> Chapter 617, does hereby adopt the following Articles Of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name and Principal Address

The name of this corporation shall be JUG CREEK CONSERVATION CLUB, INC., and its principal address shall be Suite 2810, 200 South Orange Avenue, Orlando, Florida 32801.

ARTICLE II

Term and Commencement

This corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved according to law. Corporate existence shall commence with the filing of these Articles Of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III

Purposes

The corporation has not been organized for pecuniary profit. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
