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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

YUAN FA CONFUCIANISM AND TAO ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be: YUAN FA CONFUCIANISM AND TAO ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business of this cooperation shall be 6303 Seven Springs Blvd., Greenacres, FL 33463.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are:

(a) to foster, advance and promote the study, works and teachings of Confucius, Menaces, and Taoism;

(b) To organize, conduct and maintain a religious place of worship and discussions for members, followers, and believers;

(c) To make known and instill in members, and followers the virtues and the essentials of good education so as to maintain high moral and ethical standards in men and women of all ages;

(d) To act in concert with other religious agencies, organizations and institutions to achieve the foregoing purposes and to engage in charitable activities and services in order to aid, assist, and support its members and members of the community in all facets of their life; and to

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foster an instills a spirit of friendship, benevolence and peace among mankind.

(e) To do any other act or thing incidental to or connected with the foregoing purposes or in advancement thereof, but not for the pecuniary profit or financial gain profit members, directors or officers, except as permitted under Article 5 of the not-for-Profit Corporation Law.

#### ARTICLE IV

The corporation is a nonprofit organization; it is intended to qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### ARTICLE V

The provision for qualification of members and the manner of their admission is to be provided for in the bylaws.

#### ARTICLE VI

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is to be provided for in the bylaws. The number constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is three (3); and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve initially are:

#### ARTICLE VII

This corporation is organized under a non-stock basis.

#### ARTICLE VIII

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or any private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by IRC 501(h) and does not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication of distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidates for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### ARTICLE IX

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, all of the remaining assets and property of the organization shall after payment of necessary expenses thereof be distributed to such organizations as shall qualify under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
