THIS MATTER having come to be tried before the Court without a jury on April 9 and 10, 2018, and the Court having reviewed the pleadings, having heard and considered the testimony of the parties and their witnesses, having considered the credibility and demeanor of the witnesses, having received and considered the exhibits admitted into evidence, and having heard and considered the argument of counsel addressed to the evidence and the issues tried before the Court, and being fully advised in the premises, it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Final Judgment is hereby rendered in favor of Defendant, Vietnam and All Veterans of Central Florida, Inc. and that:

- Defendant holds a possessory interest in the property at 3400 N. Tanner Road, Orlando FL by way of a lease agreement with Orange County Florida;
- 2. Because Defendant holds the lease agreement, it is entitled to possession and control of the property, as well as the items located on the property;
- No substantial, competent evidence was presented which would support a conclusion that Plaintiff has any right to possession of the property or the items located thereon;
 - Defendant, Vietnam and All Veterans of Central Florida, Inc., is entitled to possession and quiet enjoyment of the property located at 3400 N. Tanner Road, Orlando Florida, pursuant to the terms of its lease agreement with Orange County Florida; and

Defendant, Vietnam and All Veterans of Central Florida, Inc. is entitled to possession and exclusive use and control of the artifacts, items and donations located on the property at 3400 N. Tanner Road, Orlando Florida, to the exclusion of the Plaintiff, Cpl. Larry E. Smedley National Vietnam War Museum, Inc.
