Articles of Incorpation of

A Florida Non-Profit Corporation

Article One
Name
The name of this corporation is
The New City of David Pentacostal Church, Inc.

Article Two
Statement of Corporate Nature

This is a non-profit corporation organized soley for general charitable purpose pursuant to the Florida Corporation not for profit law set forth in Part 1 of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statues.

### Article Three General and Specific Purpose

- 1. The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate for the advancement of religion, charity, and education, and for other charitable purposes, by the distribution of its funds for such purposes, and particutarly to practice, teach, preach and support the precepts and teaching of christianity, according to the Testament, among the people of the State of Florida and to that end and purposes, to provide means of caring for the indigent and needy; to provide wholesome recreation for youth; homes for the aged; and hospitalization and medical care for the sick; and to provide and conduct suitable funeral and burial for their dead.
- 2. The general purposes for which this corporation is formed to opreate exclusively for such religions, charitable, and educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes the making of distribations to organization which qualify as tax-exempt organization under that code.
- 3. This corporation shall not as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene, by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise in any political campain on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Article Four Term

This Corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

Article Five Membership

The Corporation shall have a membership distinct from the Board of Trustees. The authorized number andqualification of the membership of the corporation, the manner of their admission, the different classes of membership, if any, the property voting, and other rights and priviliges of members, and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection therefore, shall be set forth in the By Laws. The qualifications for membership is this corporation shall be a confessed belief in the principals and teachings of christianity and a desire to participate and assit in the promotion of its principals and purposes among all mankind; and to that end and purpose, all persons, men and women, having good moral character or the desire for it, shall be welcome to membership. The manner of admission of members shall be by certification of approval from the Board of Directors and may be further prescribed and regulated in the rules and regulations adopted from time to time to

time by the voting memberships of the Corporation, and members may be dismissed for such causes and in such manner as may be provided by such rules and regulations.

Article Seven

Location of Principle office and identification of Registered Agent

Article Eight
Management of Corporate Affair

Board of Trustees:

The powers of this Corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a board of trustees. The number of trustees of the Corporation shall be three, provided, however, that such number may be changed by a By Laws duly adopted by the members.

Trustees elected at the first annual meeting, and at all times thereafter, shall serve for a term of one year until the first annual meeting of members following the election of trustees and until the qualification of the successors in office. Annual meetings shall be held at 8:00 O'Clock p.m., on the third Monday in July of each year at the principal office of the Corporation or at such other place or places as the Board of Trustees may designate from time to time by resolution.

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the board of trustees under any provision of law may be taken without a meeting, if all members of the board shall individually or collectively consent writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board and any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as taken by unanimous vote of the trustees. Any certificate or other document filed under any provision of law which relates to action was taken by unanimous written consent of the board of trustees without a meeting and that the articles of incorporation and by laws of this corporation authorize the trustees to so act. > Article Nine ByLaws

Subjects to the limitations contained in the bylaws, and any limitations set forth in the Corporation not for profit law of Florida, concerning corporate action that must be authorized or approved by the members in the corporation, bylaws of this Corporation may be made, altered, rescinded, added to or new bylaws may be adopted, either by a resolution of the board of trustees or by following the procedure set forth therefore in the by laws.

Article Ten

Dedication of Assets

The property of this Corporation is irrevocabily dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this Corporation shall ever ensure to the benefit of any directors officer or member thereof, or to the benefit of any provate individual.

### Article Eleven Distribution of Assets

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this Corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the Corporation, shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated excluively for religion and charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revence Code or Corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax laws.

Article Twelve
Amendments of Articles

Amendments to the articles of incorporation may be proposed by a resolution adopted by the board of trustees and presented to a quorum of members for their vote. Amendments may be adopted by the vote of two-thrids of a quorum of members of the Corporation.
