ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation shall be THE AEROSPACE EDUCATION ALLIANCE, INC.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be 1721 Northwest 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Homestead, Florida 33030.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- A. To establish an extracurricular aerospace education program to encourage students to pursue aviation and space related career paths;
- B. To establish a national aerospace education curriculum initiative and recognized courses of study in various schools and educational institutions at the elementary, secondary, and post secondary levels to gain recognition of aerospace courses and programs;
- C. To provide a forum for educators to exchange ideas and teaching techniques related to aviation and space education;
- D. To assemble and disseminate aerospace educational resources;

- E. To facilitate the development of industry-education partnerships between the aerospace industry and the educational community;
- F. To promote and develop interest on the part of the general public in aerospace education, including in the home and community;
- G. To receive gifts and grants and to make disbursements for educational purposes, including to provide technical and financial support for student associations;
- H. To sponsor a national student organization and program to promote aviation and space career development, develop leadership skills, reward student achievement, and to encourage higher achievement in math, science and technology;
- I. To provide and support conferences, workshops, and other educational development activities for educators, industry leaders, educational vendors, and government organizations involved in aerospace education for various purposes, including to involve student activities for national competitions for aerospace student associations;
- J. To provide a forum for the exchange of information and resources and for the development and maintenance of a data base for educators, schools, students, and programs in aerospace education;
- K. To develop and provide information on aerospace education for promotional, legislative, and educational purposes to establish a broad base of support for national initiatives involving aeronautics and space exploration; and
- L. To have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on non-profit corporations under the laws of the State of Florida, including the power to contract, rent, buy or sell personal or real property; provided however, that the corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of this corporation.

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on

any activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or (2) by corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publication or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable or educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any private person or persons.

On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for the payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a not for profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

#### ARTICLE IV

##### QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS

To qualify for membership in the association, an individual must be an educator who is actively teaching or who expresses in interest in teaching aviation and space education in a school or community setting.

#### ARTICLE V

##### MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors of the corporation are elected or appointed shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE VI

##### LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS

The corporate powers of the corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

#### ARTICLE VII

##### AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at any time as provided in the Bylaws of the corporation.


