## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATIONS

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

### ARTICLE I

Name of non-profit corporation

### ARTICLE II

### ARTICLE III

The specific purpose(s) for which the organization is (are)

- a. To promote equality for the people of Florida and the rest of the United States on the issues surrounding domestic violence.
- b. To promote, encourage and foster the common good and social welfare of the people of Florida by combating discrimination involving domestic advocates to promote social welfare, and by encouraging responsible conduct by government and society.
- c. To promote, encourage and foster charitable, educational or scientific activity having purposes consonant with those of the corporation.
- d. To accent, hold, invest, reinvest and administer any gifts, legacies, bequest devices, funds and property of any sort or nature and to use, expend or donate the income or principle thereof for and to devote the same to, the foregoing purposes of the corporation.
- e. To do any and all lawful acts or things which maybe necessary, useful, suitable or proper to accomplish equality for all and domestic crime prevention.

### ARTICLE IV

Dissolution of corporation

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, assets which may remain after payment and/or satisfaction of all proper claims and demands then existing against the corporation shall be distributed to such Florida charitable, crime prevention, or Equal rights oriented organization as are exempt under the Internal Revenue code, as amended. No member, trustee, officers or private person has or shall have any right, title or interest of any kind in or to such remaining assets of the corporation.

By Laws


That the above incorporations shall forthwith adopt by laws for the manner of management and operation of the corporation not inconsisted with these articles of Incorporation.


**ARTICLE IX**
