Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the National Association of Emergency Medical Services Quality Professionals, Inc.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statues, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST:

Amendments adopted:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is National Emergency Medical Services Management Association, Inc.

ARTICLE IV

A member may vote personally or by proxy appointed in writing or email.

ARTICLE XI

The annual meeting of the voting members of the corporation shall be held in March of each year or at another time designated by the Board of Directors. It shall be the duty of the President, and upon his or her failure or neglect, then of the Secretary or any officer or member, to email notices at least ten (10) days prior to this annual meeting to all members entitled to be present. Provided, however, that the Board of Directors may by two-thirds (2/3) vote elect to conduct the business of the association by email ballot in lieu of any annual meeting. Provided further, however, that if fifty (50%) per cent or more of the members of the corporation demand in writing or email, served on the President of the corporation, that an annual meeting be held, in a physical location or by

electronic meeting via email, web messaging system, conference call or live web meeting technologies, then the President shall take such steps as are necessary to hold an annual meeting not more than forty-five (45) days from the date of the receipt of such notice but not sooner than ten (10) days from such receipt of such notice.
